The Whyte Avenue Art Walk Festival is back for 2021! Like everything else we are adapting to the pandemic this year to make it a safe and fun event for everyone. The festival will run from Friday-Sunday every weekend beginning on June 4 and running through to July 31, 2021. There will be between 50-60 well-spaced artists on two floors, and a limited capacity of artists, volunteers and patrons at any given time. We will be required to follow AHS health guidance at all times (please see last page for details).

With this much excitement, our festival needs dedicated, energetic volunteers who will contribute a minimum of TWO shifts. For volunteers, one of the fun aspects is that many artists will be different from one weekend to the next, so by choosing shifts on different weekends you will see more art! And because this is an indoor event we don't need to be concerned with weather.

YOU are still a key element in creating a positive artist/visitor experience and the duties will remain similar. Setup will happen on Fridays and tear down on Sunday afternoon, but displays stay up for the weekend. Artists will still need bathroom and food breaks, as masks will be mandatory indoors. Early Friday shifts and late Sunday shifts will help direct artists as they move in and move out. As always, upon request, volunteers who keep all their shift commitments are able to receive a valuable letter of reference.

COVID-19 Safety Measures

The Whyte Avenue Art Walk must strictly adhere to all AHS public health guidelines in accordance to COVID-19. We want to ensure that all of our volunteers, staff and artists feel safe.

We will have the following measures in place

- The market layout will be set up to accommodate social distancing with 2 metres between each exhibit with the exception of an artist purchasing two booths or tables beside each other.
- MASKS are mandatory for all artists, staff, volunteers and patrons and must be worn properly over the mouth and nose
- Recommended hand sanitizing or washing hands between transactions
- Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the market however we recommend you have your own
- 15% capacity in the facility
- Entrances will be controlled
- Enhanced cleaning at the end of the day
- Load In/Load Out will be scheduled and controlled to accommodate social distancing.
- All artists, staff and volunteers will be asked to fill out and submit the AHS questionnaire prior to arriving each day
- Contact information will be required for contact tracing
- Artists, staff and volunteers are asked to notify the event organizers if experiencing any of the COVID-19 symptoms
- Artists, staff and volunteers are to follow the guidelines for testing & isolation required by AHS
- If exhibitors, staff or volunteers do not comply with, or refuse to follow the health guidelines, they will be provided a warning or asked to leave without a refund
